The ICE surge of over 3,000 Federal agents that cost the life of Renee Nicole Good is violating the Constitutional and human rights of Americans and our neighbors. This is not law enforcement. We need to say what this is: *it is a paramilitary occupation forced on Minnesotans by our Federal government because we did not vote for Donald Trump and because our leaders oppose his policies.*

Minnesota will never bend the knee to cruelty. Northfield will never bend the knee for cruelty. **Nonviolent, peaceful dissent is patriotic.** And we dissent. **Friday, January 23rd will be a statewide day of non-violent moral action, reflection: no work, no school, no shopping — only community, conscience, and collective action.**

- From Bridge Square, cross Division Street at Rare Pair, march *south* to 6th Street
- Cross at 6th Street, march *north* back to Bridge Square.
- Short final program, then peacefully disperse or **warm up** at **Goodbye Blue Monday**.

During the rally, we ask you to:

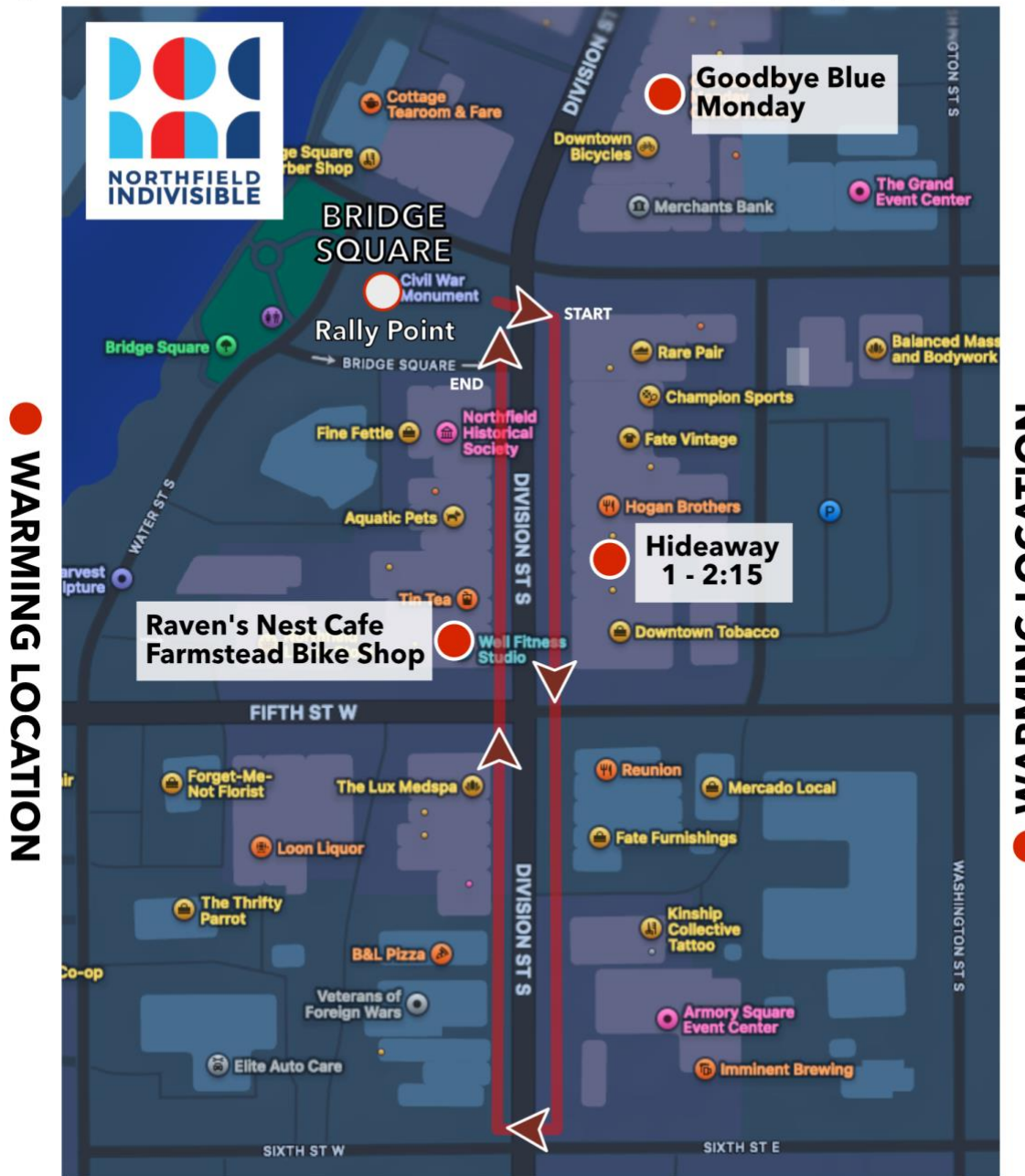

There's no such thing as bad weather, only inappropriate clothing. **We're tough.** But make no mistake, these are harsh conditions, and we want you to be safe. *No shame staying safe and warm this time, attend at your own risk*

Raise your voice peacefully & follow directions. We will rally at Bridge Square, and organize the march as soon as practicable. Bring a sign to tell ICE to leave Minnesota (consider keeping it a manageable size with expected winds), lead some chants, and connect with your neighbors and community at your event. **Remember that all events are peaceful and non-violent, so we look to de-escalate any situations that arise.** Please follow the directions of our safety marshal team.

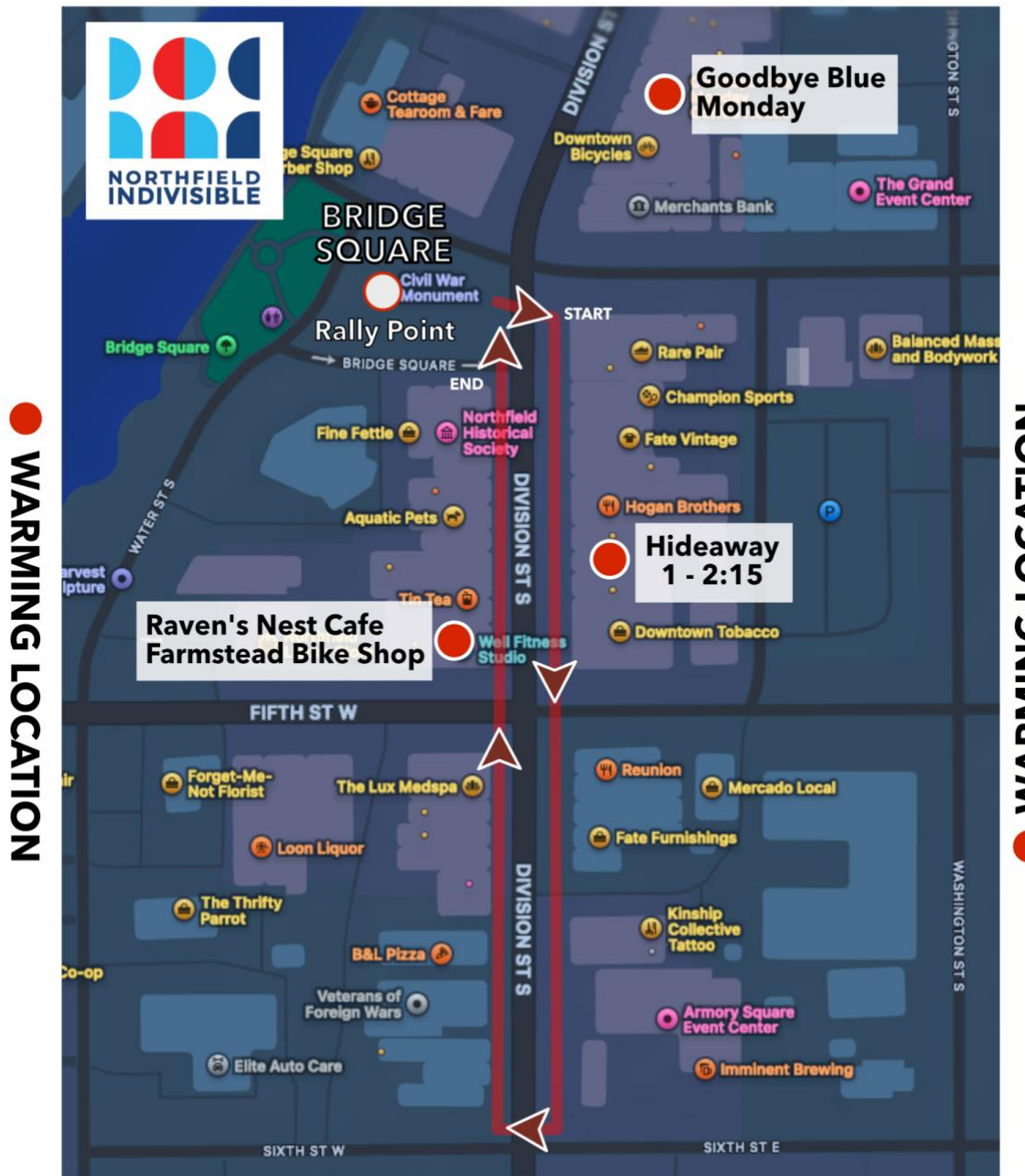
